

Following on from the launch of the Heidelberg Engineering Academy Glaucoma Faculty in 2013, we are delighted to introduce the Glaucoma Research Initiative. The Glaucoma Research Initiative is a £10,000 research grant, which will be awarded to the institution which submits the most innovative research proposal in the field of glaucoma. The top three entries will present their research proposals and the winning institution will be awarded with the funding at the Third Annual Heidelberg Engineering Glaucoma Faculty Masterclass on the 25th November 2015.

The Heidelberg Engineering Academy Glaucoma Faculty aims to:

- Promote the value of using good technique, high-quality imaging and visual field solutions
- Inspire innovative research in line with the Sight Loss and Vision Priority Setting Partnership
- Transfer skills and knowledge within the glaucoma community on a national scale

To apply for the Glaucoma Research Initiative:

- Please submit a one-page A4 grant proposal
- The submission deadline is September 30th 2015
- Submissions will be reviewed by a panel and the top three submissions will be shortlisted
- Proposals will be presented and the £10,000 research grant awarded at 2015
